PLAY FOOTBALL AGAINST OTHER LOCAL BUSINESSES AND HELP RAISE MONEY FOR CHARITY

'The Wellspring Cup' has been set up to raise funds for The Wellspring (REG NO: 1088776) and to develop a scheme to help homeless people restart or launch their own small businesses.

The Small Business Scheme is designed to help homeless people just like Martin from The Wellspring. For years Martin battled with dyslexia, leaving school 4 years behind with his learning. Despite this Martin put himself through college and became a qualified gas fitter and electrician. Martin went on to build a profitable business but sadly following a divorce he was left struggling to pay bills and sank into debt. Consequently in 2004 he was evicted from his home and slept rough in his van. Martin was lucky and found The Wellspring. To date The Wellspring has housed over 700 people, welcomes 55,000 visitors to the Centre every year and is staffed by almost 170 dedicated volunteers. With The Wellspring's support, Martin has since rebuilt his life, is now back in education and does maintenance work at The Wellspring whilst he starts to rebuild his business.

Not everyone is as lucky as Martin. Last year 5 clients died as a result of homelessness and its related issues. Many more were sent to prison or were assaulted.

How Can a Football Game Help Homeless People Like Martin?

In 'The Wellspring Cup 2010' your team will be playing against The Wellspring Lions football team. Your team, friends, family and work colleagues will be directly helping them raise much needed funds for the charity by sponsoring the tournament. By gaining sponsorship for The Wellspring Cup you will be directly helping homeless people like Martin and Aaron (who plays for The Wellspring Lions) to rebuild their lives. Take it from them; The Wellspring Cup will tackle homelessness.

"My name is Aaron. I first came to The Wellspring when I was just 16. I had nowhere to live and needed help as I was sleeping rough wherever I could. I attended The Wellspring and the staff provided me with food, clothes and a shower. I have since made some great friends from The Wellspring. With no direction and no support I was not sure where I was heading. The Wellspring helped me get in contact with and gave me the support and motivation to find a course at college. I have since enrolled in Stockport College and am doing a Level 2 Btec in construction and plumbing. I am very grateful to The Wellspring as a service and to the staff for being there when I needed them even if that was just to have a chat and brighten my mood. I am also indebted to the resident nurse Lucy, who helped me tackle some personal problems regarding STD's which I was ignorant to and I now have a lifetime supply of condoms. In a nutshell without the support through my times of need that The Wellspring has provided to me, I am not sure how my life would or could have turned out. I believe this service to be invaluable to anyone who is unfortunate to be in such a predicament. I am now settled in my own property and studying part-time all thanks to The Wellspring and its staff. I hope that The Wellspring can stay open for many years to come and continue to help disadvantaged people like myself."
